Listening skill

Listening for detailed information

Mastering the skill of attentively listening for relevant details is crucial. It enables you to extract valuable information, even if you don't fully grasp the listening material. Always have a clear idea of what you are listening for, whether it's a number, a reason, or specific examples.

As you listen, focus your attention on related words or ideas. For example, if you are asked to identify the subjects taught at Public School 294, listening for words that appear in proximity to "curriculum" or "lessons" could give you some clues.

Predicting the answer in advance may also help you focus on relevant information while listening. Based on what you know about Public School 294 (e.g., it is environment-friendly), you may guess what students might be learning there. Using both careful listening and educated guesses can help you pick out relevant details.

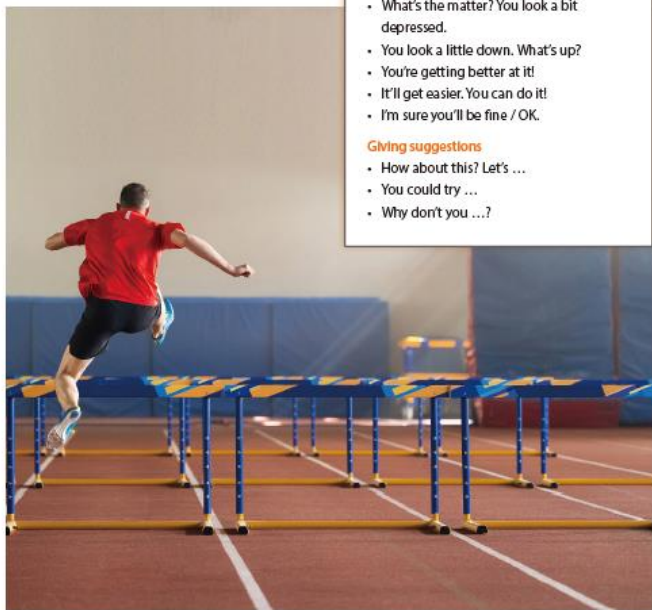

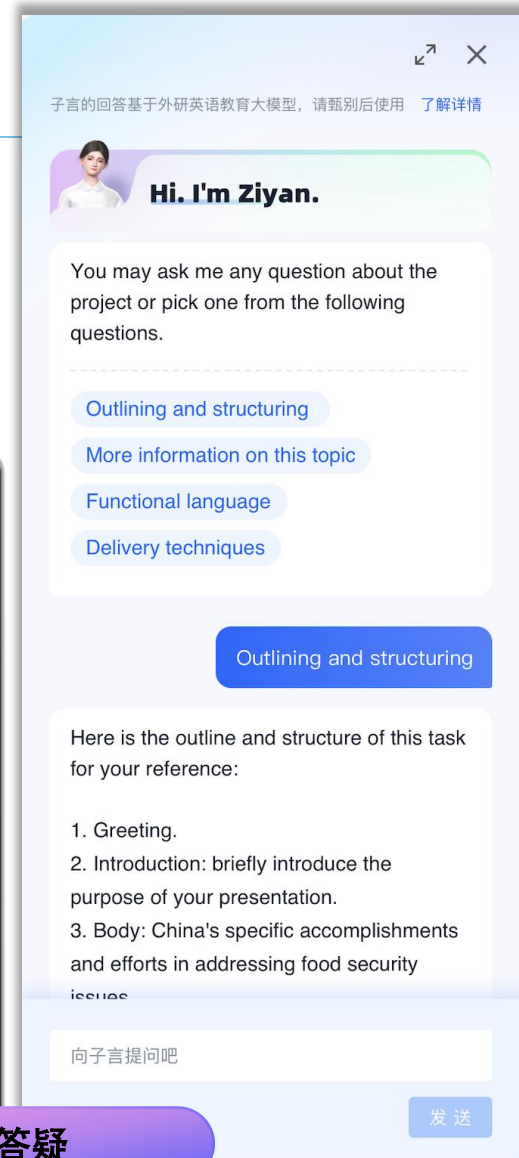
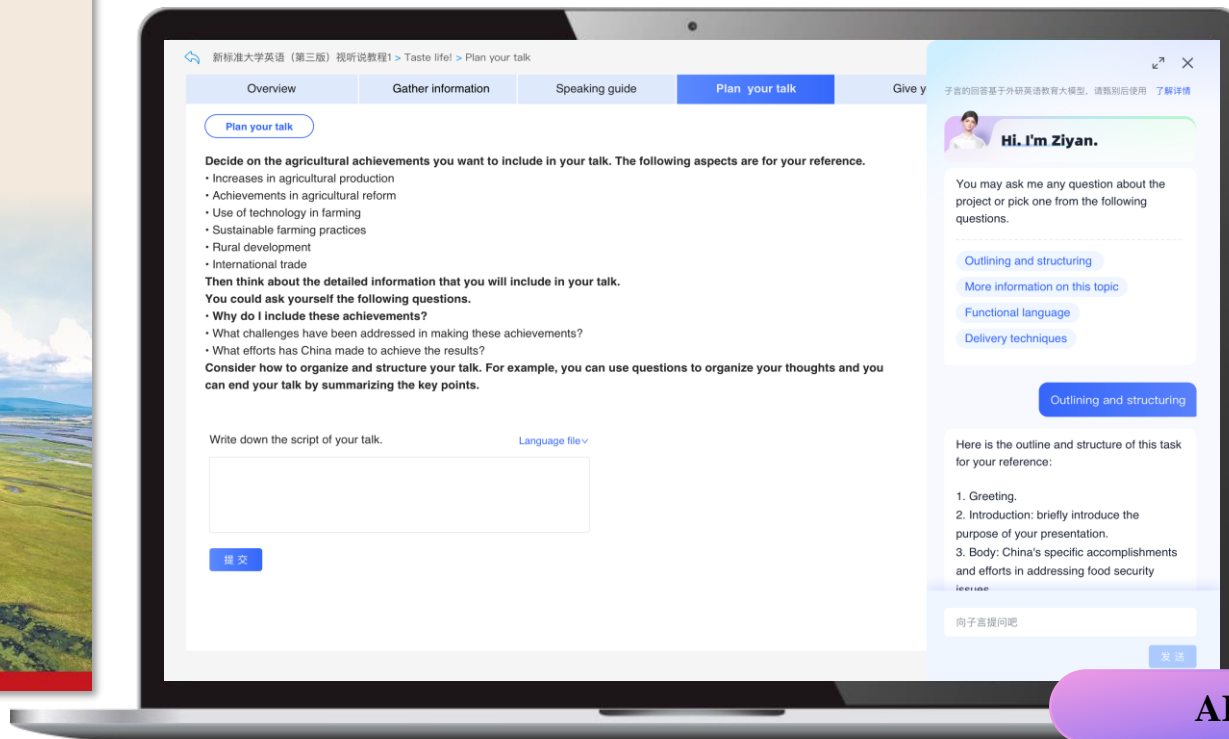
