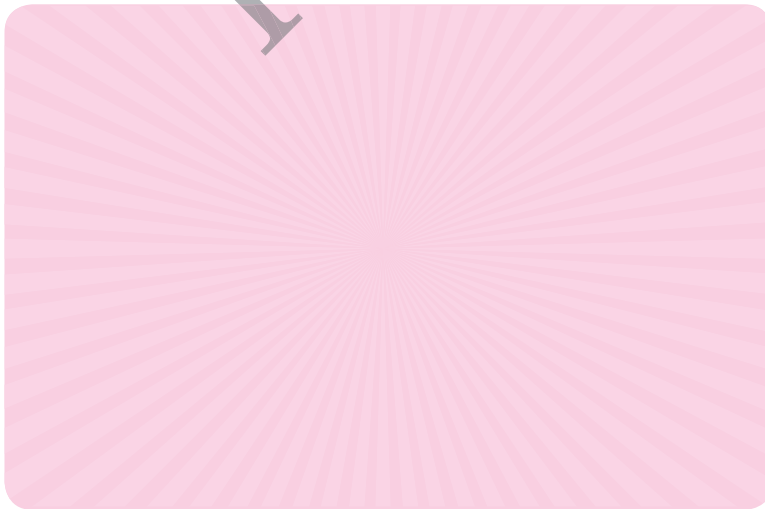

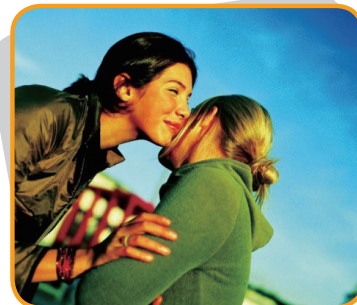

Kissing cheeks

Depending on the local culture, kissing cheeks is a common way of greeting in many countries, such as France, Spain, the US, etc. Family members, as well as friends and acquaintances, may kiss each other's cheeks when they meet or say goodbye.



Sawatdee

In Thailand, when people greet each other, they usually gently put their palms together in front of their chests while bending their heads down toward their hands. Meanwhile, they say “*sawatdee*” to each other, which means goodness, beauty or success. This term is used for both meeting and parting.

Hongi/Nose-rubbing

Hongi is a traditional Māori greeting in New Zealand. When people meet, they usually press their noses and foreheads together at the same time. It is used at traditional encounters among Māori people and at major ceremonies.

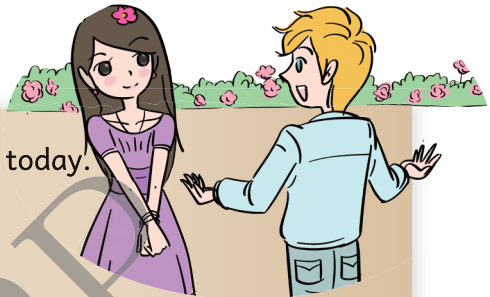
