Suggestion for the Teacher

This unit gives a brief introduction to English letters and their pronunciation. You may spend about eight hours finishing the whole unit. After the study of the first four units, this unit may serve as a reference for the revision of phonetics.

Classroom Activities

- 1. Ask the students to listen to the song *A B C* and sing along.
- 2. Write "hair" on the blackboard and ask one or two students to stand up, then ask the other students to:
 - (1) choose an appropriate pronoun referring to the student;
 - (2) choose an appropriate possessive adjective to complete the phrase "sb's hair";

(3) choose an appropriate possessive pronoun to substitute for the phrase "sb's hair". *e.g.* Li Gang: he—his hair—his

Repeat the whole procedure until the students are quite familiar with the use of different cases of personal pronouns.
